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Group 2 members created a very unique, inviting and informative statistics website which covers all required elements put forth in the assignment. The website project image and theme are consistent throughout all sections giving it a unified appearance. There were five pages including descriptive and three (required) inferential statistical components. The pages are organized and easy to navigate. I appreciate that all elements (SPSS/Excel tutorials, additional video references, help resource websites and data sets) are easy to find on the respective pages for each statistical concept. Each group member contributed through video and text explanations. Given there were four people in the group, it was easy to divide up the concepts and to expand on each. Each group member recorded at least one video. Videos and material are professionally done and create a cohesive and attractive appearance. No grammatical mistakes, SPSS was demonstrated and explained well. The concepts were presented in a way that allows the learners to understand and apply the concepts through videos, examples and write-ups. They were engaging, clear and the step-by-step directions were easy to follow. It is not possible to determine if each group member submitted a group log.

Overall the website created by Barbara, Doug, Linda and Patrick is easy to navigate and coherent. The group did an excellent job explaining and demonstrating the statistical concepts. For all the reasons above, I assigned the group a 25 out of 25.
